In the 1974, Ertl started building the Mighty Minnie or the MM puller. They were still able to be purchased in 1976, from what I found these toys were never sold through a Minneapolis Moline dealer or a White dealer, and they were only marketed through various stores. Ertl used the original Vista casting they removed the fenders, cut square sections out of the engine to clip the plastic engine in place, they also came with a black suit case weight assembly to go on the front of the tractor.
